<u>SUMMARY</u>: Under the supervision of the Animal Care Manager, this position is responsible for maintaining a safe and sanitary facility for animals and people, and providing humane handling and care for all shelter animals. Assures all animals' nutritional and housing needs are met on a daily basis. Assist with medical support and veterinary care including assisting with spay/neuter surgery and administration of medications. Works closely in a team effort with other staff members and volunteers; performs a variety of duties as needed. Participates in performing clerical and customer service duties related to the processing of animals for impoundment, and outcomes.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

Receives close supervision from Animal Care Manager; is further supervised by Animal Care Director.

<u>DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES</u> include the following:

- 1. Responsible for all duties related to the care of shelter animals with emphasis on the proper and state standardized cleaning of kennels, holding areas, and yard areas;
- 2. Assures that animals receive food and water, and provides humane handling when animals need to be moved;
- 3. Observes and evaluates animals for signs of illness and reports symptoms to appropriate personnel. Administer basic medications and vaccinations to animals and maintain accurate records;
- 4. Transports, carries, and restrains animals for treatment or examination purposes;
- 5. General housekeeping duties inside the Animal Shelter facility;
- 6. Assists with maintaining proper inventory and restocking of supplies;

<u>OTHER FUNCTIONS</u>: Performs other job related duties as directed by supervisor(s).

NOTE: The essential functions describe the general nature and level of work being performed by employees holding this position. This is not intended to be a comprehensive listing of all duties and responsibilities required, nor are all duties listed necessarily performed by any one employee so classified.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Knowledge of:

Basic methods and procedures of kennel cleaning and maintenance; Various animal species, breeds, ages, and sizes; Methods and techniques of custodial maintenance; Operational characteristics of cleaning equipment and tools; Proper usage of cleaning agents and custodial supplies; Standard office policies, procedures, and equipment; Bastrop County policies and procedures.

Ability to:

Handle animals safely and effectively; Identify signs of animal illnesses, diseases, and injuries; Perform general cleaning tasks using a variety of chemical and detergent products; Establish and maintain effective working relationships with those contacted in the course of the job; Perform various manual tasks for extended periods of time and in unfavorable weather conditions; Work a schedule which may include weekends and holidays; Perform heavy manual labor; Operate equipment required to perform essential job functions; Work independently in the absence of supervision; Learn, understand, and apply pertinent laws, rules, and regulations; Understand and follow verbal and written instructions; Communicate clearly and concisely, both verbally and in writing.

Physical Demands:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential duties of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Maintain effective audio-visual discrimination and perception needed for:

Making observations, operating assigned equipment, and communicating with others; Employee must have visual abilities including close vision, distance vision, depth perception, peripheral vision, and the ability to adjust focus.

Effectively handle a work environment and conditions which involve:

Working with various kinds of animals, Exposure to loud noise, Exposure to various weather Conditions, working closely with others, working outside normal business hours and in hours of darkness; Exposure to dust, dirt, fumes, animal waste, animal diseases, parasites, etc., and airborne particles;

Maintain physical condition needed to accomplish the performance of assigned duties and responsibilities, which may include:

Walking, sitting, stooping or standing for long periods of time, Lifting and carrying animals and heavy materials, Climbing, Crawling, Squatting, Kneeling, and Running, Performing heavy manual labor, working on uneven and/or slippery surfaces.

Maintain mental capacity sufficient to accomplish the performance of assigned duties and Responsibilities, which may include:

Effective interaction and communication with others;

Making sound decisions in a manner consistent with the essential job functions.

EXPERIENCE, EDUCATION, and LICENSING:

Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Experience:

Some knowledge and experience in handling, identifying, and caring for animals.; or any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to perform the essential job functions with preference for experience in the veterinary field.

Education:

High School graduation or its equivalent.

College Courses in Animal Care/Husbandry preferred.

Licensing:

Possession of a valid Texas driver's license.

SELECTION GUIDELINES:

Formal application; rating of education and experience; oral interview; reference and other background checks; job-related tests may be required. If an offer of employment is extended, applicant MUST PASS A PRE-EMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND DRUG SCREENING.
