



**Private Property Debris Removal (P.P.D.R.) Program**  
**Available Until February 28, 2012**

This notice is being sent to owners of homes that were destroyed by the Bastrop Complex Fire and Union Chapel Fires, who have not yet signed up for PPDR. The purpose of this correspondence is to notify you of a FEMA assistance program that will soon expire. The program is known as: "Private Property Debris Removal (P.P.D.R.)". To be eligible for PPDR, you must be the owner of record at the time the fire disaster occurred. This PPDR program has been ongoing since around mid-October, and to date, approximately 560 property owners have applied. However, the program will only be available for a limited time.

**February 28, 2012 is the last day for completing an application for PPDR.**

Generally, it is the responsibility of the property owner to remove disaster created debris from their private property. In the case of large-scale disasters, FEMA may authorize PPDR for specific disasters. The PPDR program allows the County and/or the County's contractor(s) to enter residential property for the purpose of identifying and removing fire disaster related debris that meets FEMA eligibility criteria (such as burned trees that are a safety hazard).

FEMA will fund 75% of eligible costs of the PPDR program, and Bastrop County will fund 25%. There is no cost to the property owner to participate in PPDR.

SAIC is the company that has been hired as the County's consultant to help manage the various FEMA assistance programs Bastrop County is utilizing in our recover efforts. SAIC is the beginning point for property owners that choose to participate in the PPDR process.

In order to participate in PPDR, go to the SAIC office at:  
201 Hunters Crossing Blvd, Unit 9 (near Home Depot) and complete/bring the following information (all persons, shown as owners on the deed, must participate):

1. Right Of Entry/Hold Harmless Agreement
2. Proof of Property Ownership
3. Copy of Homeowner's Insurance policy
4. Your Drivers License
