## VTR 68-A INSPECTION

The Bastrop County Sheriff's Auto Theft Unit is responsible for the VTR 68-A inspections for Bastrop County Resident's. Inspections are by appointment only on specific dates set by the investigator. The inspection location will be on Jackson street just past (south of) the Tax Office and Sheriff's Office entrances. Inspections WILL NOT be done at your residence or any location other than the Sheriff's Office. NO EXCEPTIONS, it is your responsibility to make arrangements to have your vehicle or trailer brought to the designated location. An Auto Theft Investigator is the only person who can conduct a 68-A inspection. You need to bring your photo ID and the vehicle's title. If you have a homemade trailer or vehicle that is not titled, you need to bring written proof of manufacture, bill of sale, and any other documentation you may have to substantiate its manufacture or ownership. If your vehicle was a gift or inheritance, please bring any related documentation.

All vehicles and trailers are subject to seizure as defined by the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Chapter 47 if the vehicle/trailer manufacturer's VIN has been removed, obliterated, or altered.

\*\*\*NOTE: if there is inclement weather (raining, ice, snow etc..), County offices are closed for unforeseen events or the Investigator is called for other duty assignments or emergencies, the 68-A inspections will be cancelled and YOU will be responsible for rescheduling your appointment. You can call 512-549-5100 prior to your appointment to ascertain if the inspections have been cancelled.
