Conduct a Public Hearing on the adoption of the proposed ad valorem tax rate of \$0.08488 per \$100 valuation, consisting of a separately approved Debt Rate of \$0.01087 per \$100 valuation and a separately approved Maintenance and Operations Rate of \$0.07401 per \$100 valuation for tax year 2025 per Chapter 26, Texas Tax Code.

Discussion and action on the District's 2025 ad valorem tax rate consisting of a separately approved Debt Rate of \$0.01087 per \$100 valuation and a separately approved Maintenance and Operations Rate of \$0.07401 per \$100 valuation, adopt an Order Levying Taxes for 2025 and authorize filing the Order with the Bastrop County Tax Assessor/Collector and other appropriate authorities per Chapter 26 Texas Tax Code.
