

All previously ordered parent-child visitation scheduled to take place through May 31, 2020 is **HEREBY ORDERED SUSPENDED** in an effort to contain the spread of the coronavirus (COVID-19) and to protect all parties. Any party may file a written request for face to face visitation with full details including time, place, and manner for any requested visitation. The Court may decide the issue of requested visitation by hearing or submission, at its discretion.
- §2. The Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) is **HEREBY ORDERED** to make arrangements for telephonic, Skype, Facetime, or Zoom communications in place of in-person visitation between through May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020.
