GENERAL ORDERS

ORDER RELATING TO THE FILING OF FAMILY LAW CASES IN BASTROP COUNTY, TEXAS

In order to confirm the existing policy of the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas and the 21st, 335th, 423rd and 465th Judicial District Courts, and to clarify such policy, this order is being signed directing the District Clerk of Bastrop County, Texas, as to the procedure to follow in the filing of family law cases (except CPS and Juvenile cases) in Bastrop County, Texas.

It is therefore Ordered that the District Clerk of Bastrop County, Texas, shall file ½ (50%) of all family law cases (except CPS and Juvenile cases) in the 465th District Court, Bastrop County, Texas, ¼ (25%) of all family law cases (except CPS and Juvenile cases) in the 423th District Court, Bastrop County, Texas and the other ¼ (25%) shall be filed in the County Court at Law, Bastrop County, Texas, on a rotating basis. All CPS and Juvenile cases will continue to be filed in the County Court at Law of Bastrop, Texas. Any hearings or trials on such family law cases will be heard in the court where the case was originally filed unless transferred accordingly. Any case originally filed in the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas, that cannot be heard by the Judge of the County Court at Law because of recusal or otherwise will be heard by the 423th District Courts of Bastrop County, Texas and likewise. Any case originally filed in the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas and/or the 423th Or 465th District Courts of Bastrop County, that cannot be heard by either the Judge of the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas or the Judges of the 423th District Courts, Bastrop County, Texas, because of recusal or otherwise, may be heard by the District Judge of the 21sth or 335th Judicial District Courts at the direction of the District Judge of the 21sth or the 335th Judicial District Courts.
