Cremation Authorization Request Policy

In accordance with §716.004 of the Texas Health and Safety Code, the following policy has been adopted by this court to request cremation of human remains within the 48-hour period following the time of death indicated on the death certificate.

Requests for a waiver of the 48-hour waiting period for cremation shall be submitted via email at any time to <u>Zachary.carter@co.bastrop.tx.us</u> or hand delivered during business hours to the office at 1624 NE Loop 230 Smithville, TX 78957. The request must include the requestor's name, and business name if a funeral home or crematory, the decedent's name, and the date of death.
