**RESCINDING ORDER
PROHIBITING
OUTDOOR BURNING**

WHEREAS, Section 352.081 of the Local Government Code provides that the commissioners court of a county, by order, may prohibit outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county if the commissioners court makes a finding that circumstances present in the unincorporated area create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2020, the Bastrop County Commissioners Court approved a countywide Burn Ban until September 14, 2020, with provisions for the County Judge may terminate said Burn Ban if conditions warrant, upon council with fire chiefs and the Office of Emergency Management; and

WHEREAS, the Bastrop County Judge does hereby find that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Bastrop County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED that the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning for portions of the unincorporated areas of Bastrop County, Texas, dated August 24, 2020, be rescinded effective at 12:00 Noon on Thursday, September 10, 2020.
