**RESCINDING THE  
ORDER  
PROHIBITING  
OUTDOOR BURNING**


**WHEREAS**, Section 352.081 of the Local Government Code provides that the commissioners court of a county, by order, may prohibit outdoor burning in the unincorporated area of the county if the commissioners court makes a finding that circumstances present in the unincorporated area create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Bastrop County Commissioners Court does hereby find that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of Bastrop County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, and;


**BE IT THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning for portions of the unincorporated areas of Bastrop County, Texas dated August 27, 2018 be rescinded effective at 9:01 am.




