

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.39353</u> per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.37421</u> per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$ <u>0.39353</u> per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2023 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for BASTROP COUNTY from the same properties in both the 2022 tax year and the 2023 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that BASTROP COUNTY may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that BASTROP COUNTY is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2023 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON 09/11/2023 09:30 AM
at Commissioner's Courtroom 2nd Floor, 804 Pecan St, Bastrop, TX.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, BASTROP COUNTY is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Commissioners Court of BASTROP COUNTY at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by BASTROP COUNTY last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by BASTROP COUNTY this year.

No-New-Revenue Maintenance and Operations Rate Adjustments

State Criminal Justice Mandate (counties)

The Bastrop County Auditor certifies that Bastrop County has spent \$ 26,064 in the previous 12 months for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Bastrop County Sheriff has provided Bastrop information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for the reimbursement of such costs.

This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.00010 /\$100.

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures (counties)

The BASTROP COUNTY spent \$ 1,125,155 from July 1 2022 to June 30 2023 on indigent health care compensation procedures at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance.

For current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$ 166,919.

This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.00147 /\$100.

Indigent Defense Compensation Expenditures (counties)

The BASTROP COUNTY spent \$ 640,224 from July 1 2022 to June 30 2023 to provide appointed counsel for indigent individuals in criminal or civil proceedings in accordance with the schedule of fees adopted under Article 26.05, Code of Criminal Procedure, and to fund the operations of a public defender's office under Article 26.044, Code of Criminal Procedure, less the amount of any state grants received. For current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent defense compensation expenditures is \$ 152,532.

This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by 0.00021 /\$100.
