DUPLICATE BALLOTS BY MAIL

It has come to my attention that there has been a significant error in the processing and mailing of ballots from our third party vendor for the 2020 Democratic and Republican Primary elections. We have been made aware that several voters have received multiple ballots by mail.

I express our deepest apologies for the error. I assure voters that their already cast ballots have been tracked, logged, and locked in ballot boxes for processing on Election Day. Our tracking process will not allow for the processing of more than one ballot per voter. Once a ballot is cast, received, and logged in our office, any other ballots returned by that voter would be null and void.

If you have not yet cast your ballot, you may complete one of the ballots received and mail it back to our office. The same tracking process will apply.

We recommend that you destroy all duplicate ballots you have received. If you prefer, you may return them to our office.

Finally, I assure the voters of Bastrop County that there is no way that this error can contribute to any mechanism for the perpetration of any voter fraud. Any duplicate ballots submitted will not be counted.
