ITEMS FOR ADDENDUM #1:

Q: Have any Notices or Letters of Intent (NOI or LOI's) been submitted to the Texas Department of Emergency Management (TDEM) on behalf of Bastrop County regarding specific project types the County is interested in relation to the attached Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)?
