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ITEMS FOR ADDENDUM #2:

Q: Addendum 1 is erroneous, surrounding the culvert dimensions. There are never any extensions necessary to skew a culvert. If Bastrop County is certain of the overall dimensions (out to out) of the headwall to headwall 26'. The 45-degree skewed culvert is 37' (+/-) of 2-8'x6' culvert.

A: The extensions are only applicable if the contractor proposes pre-cast concrete box culverts. The total overall length as stated in the bid sheet quantities is 74 linear feet.

Q: Is Bastrop County certain a 12' headwall is long enough? 12' only allows for a (+/-) 1.8:1 slope at 6.67' tall.

A: 12ft long headwalls are correct. Bastrop County is aware of the slope and FEMA has approved of this project scope.

Q: The downstream fence is approximate, and dimensions are called for the rip rap to stop at the fence. Please give dimensions of the upstream rip rap limits.

A: The project estimate assumes a 50ft ROW and the rip rap estimate is 60 tons. The project will be paid for using a lump sum total, but Bastrop County will pay Contractor for documented overage of rip rap placed.

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
